

MONOSYLLABIC WORD MEMORY

INSTRUCTIONS:

The objective is to collect the most pairs of cards.

- 1. Shuffle the cards and lay them on the table, face down, in rows.
- 2. The youngest player goes first. Play then continues in a clockwise direction.
- 3. On each turn, a player turns over any two cards (one at a time) and keeps them if the pictures on the cards match.
- 4. If they successfully match a pair they get to keep the cards, and that player gets another turn.
- 5. When a player turns over two cards that do not match, those cards are turned face down again (in the same position) and it becomes the next player's turn.
- 6. The trick is to remember which cards are where.
- 7. The person with the most pairs at the end of the game wins.
