# Climate Action Days

## What is climate action?

Any activity that responds to climate change can be climate action. Most climate actions fall into two groups:

**1**

Reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. This is called “**mitigation.**”

**2**

Adapting to climate hazards, like very hot weather or storms. This is called “**adaptation.**” (Source: NASA)

For Climate Action Days, schools will plan activities that best serve their students. They can teach students fun ways to have a positive impact or celebrate the ways they already take action.


