We are currently scheduling *The Child Safety Workshop* for the 2015-2016 school years. The Workshop provides third and fourth graders with the tools to decipher between safe and unsafe touch, as well as providing the opportunity to discuss the content of the program privately with a Prevention Specialist or a school Guidance Counselor directly following the Workshop. This affords children who have already experienced some type of abuse the opportunity to ask for help and begin the process of intervention immediately.

In order to qualify for the *Child Safety Workshop*, a school Guidance Counselor or Social Worker must attend CAPP's all day Professional Training every three years.

New counselors are welcome to attend CAPP's Professional Training on February 2<sup>nd</sup> from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM at The Bronx Museum of Arts, 1040 Grand Concourse, Conference Room (South Wing) Bronx, NY 10456. Space is limited.
