Dear Parents/ Guardians,

The Forest Park School - PS97Q is a mandated Uniform School. Uniforms are mandated beginning the first day of school, which is Thursday, September 4, 2014. All Pre-K through Fifth Grade Students and parents shall be expected to comply with the Forest Park School Uniform Requirement.

NEW SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENT - *Clothing can be purchased at any vendor/store.*

Tops:

Plain white or light blue colored tops. Tops can be short or long sleeve shirts in a button-down shirt or polo shirt (Logos/brands, patterns, ornaments, etc. are not acceptable). Navy blue sweaters and ties are optional.

Bottoms:

Navy blue colored bottoms. Bottoms can include dress pants, cargo pants, shorts, skorts or skirts (Logos/brands, patterns, ornaments, etc. are not acceptable). Shirts should remain tucked in with belt visible. Shorts, skorts, or skirts should be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.

Shoes:

Black shoes, sneakers and boots with rubber soles for running and playing, no heels. Stockings can be navy blue or white.

DISCIPLINE

Students are required to attend school in their uniform. Please visit the Chancellor's Regulation A-665: Uniform Policy at www.schools.nyc.gov for a complete explanation of the uniform mandate (Rules & Policies).

PARENTAL RIGHT TO SECURE AN EXEMPTION

A student's parent has the right to secure an exemption from the policy. In order to secure an exemption, the student's parent must meet with administration. They will also be required to complete a Uniform Exemption Request.
