[Move-to-Improve](#) (MTI) is a FREE professional development that trains NYC public school K-5 classroom teachers to engage students in active learning to improve academic achievement. Designed for the K-5 classroom, MTI activities can be easily adapted for students with disabilities. The activities are a great way to transition from one lesson to the next and to refocus and re-energize students. Teachers receive free MTI materials and curriculum, as well as UFT negotiated training rate (no cost to schools). **All Citywide APE teachers and District 75 Classroom and PE teachers serving grades K-5 are encouraged to attend.** (School support staff, including Paras, OTs, and PTs, will be accommodated if space allows, though only teachers are eligible for the MTI workshop materials.)
