Educational Impact Statement

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

In the 2010-2011 school year, P.S. 114 (09X114, "P.S. 114"), an existing school serving grades K-4, will implement a grade reconfiguration plan to expand its current grade configuration to K-5. P.S. 114 is housed in school building X114 (hereinafter referred to as "X114"), located at 1155 Cromwell Avenue, Bronx in Community School District 9 ("District 9"). There are no other schools currently co-located in X114 with P.S. 114. X114 has a capacity of 636 and its 2008-2009 target utilization rate was 118%. This proposal addresses the need to create grade alignment and improve student access to middle school choice.
