What does the "S" mean in the table above?

The New York City Department of Education is a public agency that is required to protect the privacy of students and families by complying with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). To comply with this law, the NYCDOE does not report student data in cases where the number of students is less than 10. For example, in a district where the number of qualifiers is less than 10, you would see "S" in the data results table, since the information is suppressed.
