Family Life Academy Charter School (FLACS) is a K-8 non-profit, public charter school that educates 334 kindergarten through sixth grade low-income, minority, and immigrant children in the Highbridge area of the Bronx. Founded in 2001 FLACS’s mission is “to empower all students to achieve high standards, help them take responsibility for their own learning, and encourage them to explore and affirm human values.” FLACS was founded as a K to 5 in response to Highbridge’s poor performance in the local, traditional public schools. Due to its breakthrough achievements with its elementary school population, FLACS’s authorizer, the Charter Schools Institute, approved an expansion from K-5 to K-8 in the spring of 2009. FLACS will educate 468 students in K-8 by September 2011. FLACS’s strong instructional program is mission-driven, research and data-supported, and family-centered. FLACS is a school that responds quickly to students needs, implements innovative teaching strategies, and has high expectations for its students, faculty and staff.
