Since there is only one candidate the election scheduled for Wednesday May 9, 2012 as per Pension Memorandum No. 1, 2011-2012 issued on March 20, 2012, is hereby cancelled and no further action is required in schools, colleges or other units.

In accordance with Section 13-507 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, the Chancellor will cast one ballot for this candidate and duly declare him elected as a Teacher-Member of the Teachers' Retirement Board for the term of office beginning May 2012 and ending May 2015.
