1.2	December 25, 1996	Christmas	No Released Time Classes.
1.3	January 1, 1997	Winter Recess	No Released Time Classes.
1.4	February 19, 1997	Mid-Winter Recess	No Released Time Classes.
1.5	April 2, 1997	Easter Week	No Released Time Classes except for Students of the Jewish Faith
1.6	April 23, 1997	Spring Recess	No Released Time Classes.
