

This is a proposal to move Greenwich Village Middle School (GVMS, 02M896), an existing school serving students in grades six through eight, to a new location. GVMS is currently co-located with PS 03M, an elementary school. GVMS would move to a newly constructed building where it would be co-located with Urban Assembly School of Business for Young Women (02M316). GVMS would continue to serve grades six through eight in its new location. This move would make space available for PS 03M to serve additional elementary school students in its current location.

- **Impacts on Affected Students:**

Students currently attending Greenwich Village Middle School in the M003 building located at 490 Hudson Street will be served in its new location at 26 Broadway.

- **Proposed or Potential Use of Building:**

M282 is planned to serve students at the secondary level.

- **Effect on personnel needs; costs of instruction, administration, transportation and other support services**

Greenwich Village Middle School expects to hire additional teachers due to the increased organizational capacity of its new building; the number of positions added will be based on the release of annual enrollment projections in the spring.

No additional administrative staff positions are expected as a result of the re-location.

Consistent with city-wide policy, students in grades seven and eight would not be eligible for busing; there is a potential for an increase in transportation costs related to bus service for some students in grade six.

Curriculum materials and supplies will be purchased as needed to accommodate the students.

- a. Physical condition – New building. Building condition assessment not available.
