

Diversity in Admissions Pilot

Brooklyn School of Inquiry (20K686) will be piloting a new admissions policy starting with students applying for placement for kindergarten in September 2017 designed to help foster diversity within the school.

As part of the new admissions pilot, the school will give priority to students eligible for Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) for kindergarten. Families who meet this criteria, and all other interested families, are encouraged to sign up to take the Gifted & Talented Test, to see if they may be eligible to apply.

The deadline to submit a Gifted & Talented Request for Testing (RFT) is November 14, 2016. You can submit your RFT:

- Online at schools.nyc.gov/ApplyOnline
- In person at a Family Welcome Center (8am – 3pm, Mon-Fri)

Families who miss the November 14 deadline can email ESenrollment@schools.nyc.gov, to see if it possible for their child to test for the 2017-18 school year.

Brooklyn School of Inquiry is a Citywide G&T program, so children must score 97 or higher on the G&T exam to be eligible to apply. Citywide G&T programs accept students from all boroughs without preference for their district of residence.

All seats will be filled using a child's test score and the admissions priorities outlined below. Students eligible for FRL will be prioritized for 40% of seats. Any seats remaining after FRL priority is given will be considered as part of the larger admissions pool.
