Details: This public hearing is open to anyone interested in learning about the following charter revision and renewal for a school located in **Community School District 9 in The Bronx.**

Success Academy Charter School –Bronx 2 is located at 450 St. Paul’s Place Bronx, NY 10456 and 270 E. 167TH Street Bronx, NY 10456 in CSD 9. The education corporation seeks an extension of its authority to operate the school from February 17, 2015 to July 31, 2015. Thereafter, it seeks a five year renewal of its authority to operate the school. According to the renewal application, the school would serve approximately 962 students in grades K-10.

The mission of Success Academy – Bronx 2 is to provide students in New York City with an exceptionally high-quality education that gives them the knowledge, skills, character, and disposition to meet and exceed NY State Common Core Learning Standards, and the resources to lead and succeed in school, college, and a competitive global economy.
