High Schools at a Glance is designed to help you quickly identify high schools to which your child may wish to apply. What follows is a comprehensive chart, organized by borough, listing every high school and its five most important features:

- 1) **Program Name** – Each program a school offers has a distinct name, which must be included on your high school application.
- 2) **Program Code** – Each program has a distinct 4-character program code, which also must be included on your high school application.
- 3) **Interest Area** – Each program has a specified interest area selected from the list below. In this publication, each interest area is assigned a separate vertical column, allowing you to quickly identify programs that share a particular interest area. The interest areas include:

- 4) **Selection Method** – Each program will have its own selection method (listed in the column of the program’s interest area). The selection methods are described below:

A Audition – Programs that require you to demonstrate proficiency in a specific performing arts area. Audition requirements, dates and times for specific programs are listed in the High School Directory.

E Educational Option (Ed. Opt.) – Programs for which fifty percent (50%) of the students are ranked by school personnel and fifty percent (50%) are randomly selected by computer. Both groups are chosen according to the following distribution of the previous year’s standardized test scores in reading:

- 16% in the high reading range*
- 68% in the average reading range
- 16% in the low reading range

* Students who score in the **Top 2%** on this test and list an Ed. Opt. program first on their application are guaranteed a match to that program.

L Limited Unscreened – Programs that select students randomly by computer. Priority is given to students who, with their parents, demonstrate interest in a school by attending its information session, open house events or fairs.

S Screened – Programs in which school personnel rank students based on their previous year’s final academic record, standardized test scores, attendance and punctuality. You should review the selection criteria for each screened program (listed in the High School Directory) to determine whether you wish to apply.

T Test – Programs that require you to take the Specialized High Schools Admissions Test (SHSAT) for entrance.

U Unscreened – Programs for which students are selected randomly by computer.

Z Zoned – Programs that give priority to students who live in the geographical zoned area of the high school.

8 Continuing 8th graders – Programs open only to 8th grade students who are currently enrolled at a school with both middle and high school grades and who wish to continue to the high school.

To learn more about the programs listed in this publication, including their course highlights, extracurricular activities and PSAL sports teams, please consult the page listed for that school in the Directory.

In addition to the information provided in the Directory, if you are interested in finding more information regarding a school’s performance, visit the Department of Education homepage www.nyc.gov/schools and type in the name of the school. When a list of schools appears, click on the school you wish to learn about. When the school’s page appears, click on “Statistics” in the left hand column. This will give you access to many school statistics including the Learning Environment Survey Report, the Quality Review Report, the Progress Report and the Annual School Report Card.

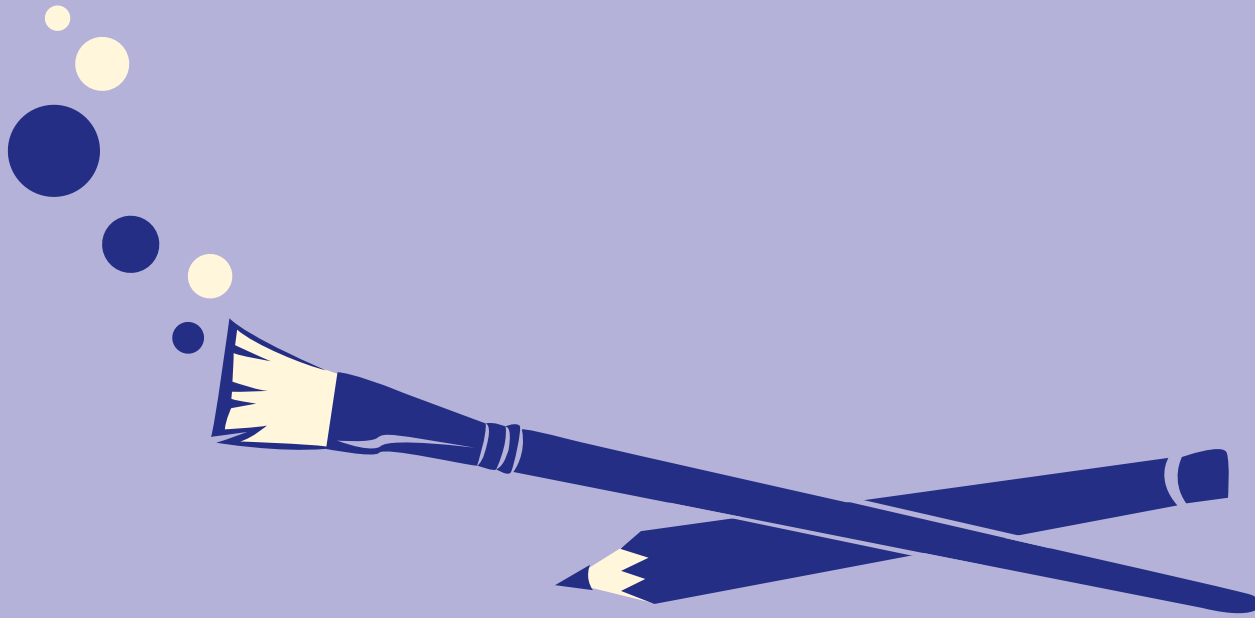
