<p>Girls Preparatory Charter School of New York, an existing charter school located at 442 East Houston Street, New York, NY and 420 East 12th Street, New York, NY 10009 in Community School District (“CSD”) 1, currently serves 550 in grade K-8, proposes to merge with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boys Preparatory Charter School of New York, a charter school that has not opened to be located at 1695 Seward Avenue, Bronx, NY 10473 in CSD 8, which will serve 132 students in grades K-1 in the 2014-15 school year; and • Girls Preparatory Charter School of the Bronx, an existing charter school located at 681 Kelly Street, Bronx, NY 10455 and 890 Cauldwell Avenue, Bronx, NY 10456 in CSD 8, which currently serves 445 students in grade K-5. <p>If the merger is approved, Girls Preparatory Charter School of New York would be the successor education corporation under the new corporate name “Public Prep Charter School Academies.” Following the merger, the schools would continue under their current names. Each education corporation seeks a revision to its charter to permit it to merge with the other education corporation. The proposed merger would be effective July 1, 2014, or at the close of the next succeeding fiscal quarter, whichever occurs first.</p> <p>Please note that post merger there would be only one EIN and one NYC vendor number for all schools as all assets, liabilities and contracts would be under the corporate structure of the successor education corporation, Girls Preparatory Charter</p>	

School of New York.

This school is authorized by the State University of New York (SUNY) Trustees. If the SUNY Trustees declines to renew the school's charter, the school will close at the conclusion of the current charter term. More information can be accessed at: www.newyorkcharters.org.
