AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION OF THE CHANCELLOR

Number: C-175

Subject: PER SESSION EMPLOYMENT

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

Chancellor's Regulation C-175 sets forth the rules and limitations governing per session services provided by pedagogic employees. The proposed amendments, which update the regulation issued on June 9, 2009, define per session services, set forth limitations on hours that may be earned in particular titles, explain the circumstances under which per session may be served, and provide for an approval process and a waiver process.

II. Substantial revisions to the item.

- a. The definition of per session services was revised to align more closely with the definition in the prior regulation (issued in 2009).
- b. The provision allowing waiver of the regulation if deemed to be in the best interests of the school system has been deleted from the proposed regulation.
- c. The language concerning pedagogues who have been reassigned from their positions not being allowed to work per session has been deleted from the proposed regulation.
- d. The per session application form, OP-175, is an attachment to the regulation.

III. Summary of all public comments received on the item following the initial public notice.

- a. A comment was received stating that the definition of per session in the proposed regulation was not sufficiently similar to the definition in the prior regulation.
- b. A comment was made that waiver of the regulation is not permissible.
- c. A comment was made objecting to the cap on hours for principals and the language concerning pedagogues who have been reassigned from their positions not being allowed to perform per session service.
- d. One commenter requested that the OP-175 form be attached to the proposed regulation, as it is attached to the current regulation.
