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## RESOLUTION 00-13

May 7, 2015,

The following resolution was presented to the public at the Community District Education Council 28 Calendar Meeting held on Thursday May 7, 2015 at 90-27 Sutphin Boulevard, Jamaica, New York.

**RESOLUTION 00-13 – CEC 28 APPROVAL OF ZONING PLAN TO CREATE AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ZONE FOR THE NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN NEW BUILDING Q314; LOCATED AT 88-08 164<sup>th</sup> STREET. THE NEW SCHOOL IS OPENING FOR THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR; HOWEVER, THE PROPOSED ZONE WOULD BE IMPLEMENTED FOR THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR. TO ALLEVIATE THE OVERCROWDING IN P.S. 182 AND P.S. 86.**

**CURRENT EXISTING SHARED ZONE OF P.S. 86 AND P.S. 182. SCHOOLS INVOLVED IN THE PROPOSAL: PS.314 (Q314) PS.86 (Q086), P.S. 182 (Q182)**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that Community Education Council approve the following Zoning plan which is designed to represent the families that live in the “sending” elementary school zone regardless of where they attend elementary school currently.

1. **A statement of how students will be admitted to the affected schools:** The proposed changes would impact only incoming pre-kindergarten or kindergarten students or students that are new to the system in 2016-2017. All currently enrolled students may remain in their school. Children entering pre-kindergarten and kindergarten whose verified siblings are enrolled in a school impacted by a re-zoning plan adopted by the CEC will maintain zoned sibling priority to that impacted school.
  - a. Students will be enrolled in New York City pre-kindergarten programs by the following priority:
    1. Students residing in the zone, who have a sibling at the school in grades K-5 in September 2015.<sup>1</sup>
    2. Students residing in the zone, who do not have a sibling at the school.<sup>1</sup>
    3. Students residing in the district, who have a sibling at the school,
      - a. who have no zoned school or whose zoned school has no pre-K program, then
      - b. who are zoned to a different school which has a pre-K program.
    4. Students residing in the borough, who have a sibling at the school.
    5. Students residing out-of-borough, who have a sibling at the school.
    6. Students residing in the district,
      - a. who have no zoned school or whose zoned school has no pre-K program, then
      - b. who are zoned to a different school which has a pre-K program.
    7. Students residing in the borough.



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8. Students residing out-of-borough.
- b. Students will be enrolled in New York City elementary schools by the following priority:
  1. Zoned students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year
  2. Zoned students other than those in (1) above applying to the zoned school
  3. Students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year who are not zoned to the school,
    - a. Within District first, then
    - b. Out of District
  4. Students currently attending the school's pre-kindergarten program who reside outside the school's zone, *without* a sibling who will be in grades K-5 at the school in the following school year,
    - a. Within District first, then
    - b. Out of District
  5. Students other than those in (3a) and (4a) above who are residents of that district
  6. Students other than those in (3b) and (4b) who are residents of another district

**Public School Q314:** Beginning at the corner of Hillside Avenue and 168<sup>th</sup> Street; then South on 168<sup>th</sup> Street; then West below Archer Avenue; along the LIRR Main Line; then North on 160<sup>th</sup> Street; then West on Jamaica Avenue; then North on Parson Boulevard; then East on 89<sup>th</sup> Avenue; then North on 164<sup>th</sup> Street; including both sides of 164<sup>th</sup> Street; then East on Hillside Avenue to 168<sup>th</sup> Street (Point of Origin).

**Public School 86:** Beginning at the corner of Hillside Avenue and 168<sup>th</sup> Street; then North on 168<sup>th</sup> Street; then West on Grand Central Parkway; then North on 164<sup>th</sup> Street; then West on Goethals Avenue; then South on Parsons Boulevard; then West on the Grand Central Parkway; then South on 150<sup>th</sup> Street; then West on 85<sup>th</sup> Avenue; then South on 148<sup>th</sup> Street; then East on Hillside Avenue; then South on 162<sup>nd</sup> Street; then East on 89<sup>th</sup> Avenue; then North on 164<sup>th</sup> Street; not including either side of 164<sup>th</sup> Street; then East on Hillside Avenue to 168<sup>th</sup> Street (Point of Origin)

**Public School 182:** Beginning at the corner of Hillside Avenue and 148<sup>th</sup> Street; then East on Hillside Avenue; then South on 162<sup>nd</sup> Street; then West on 89<sup>th</sup> Avenue; then South on Parsons Boulevard; then East on Jamaica Avenue; then South on 160<sup>th</sup> Street; then West below Archer Avenue, along the LIRR Main Line; then West on Jamaica Avenue; then North on 148<sup>th</sup> Street; then East on 90<sup>th</sup> Avenue; then North on 148<sup>th</sup> Street to Hillside Avenue (Point of Origin).

**NOTE: ALL ZONE LINES TO BE DRAWN ALONG THE CENTER OF VEHICULAR OR TRANSPORTATION RIGHTS OF WAY, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED OTHERWISE.**

**EXPLANATION:** The zoning plan was presented to the community at a public meeting on the evening of Thursday April 16, 2015 at P.S 182 located at 153-27 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Jamaica, NY. Community feedback was taken at that meeting as well as being accepted at CEC Calendar Meeting on May 7, 2015. The approved zoning plan will be submitted to the Department of Education, Office of District Planning for final review and implementation.
