1.0 PARTICIPATING IN PRE-K FOR ALL

New York City offers every four-year-old child a free, high-quality pre-K seat through the Pre-K for All program. Pre-K for All is a program that runs five days a week from September through June. All families with children born in 2013 are eligible to begin pre-K in September 2017. All students, including students with disabilities, should apply to pre-K. Please see Section 6.1 for more information on students with disabilities. Pre-K for All programs build on the strengths and backgrounds of all students and families. See Section 6.3 for more information on students from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds. All of these students should apply for pre-K.

Most pre-K programs are full-day, or 6 hours and 20 minutes long. All Pre-K for All programs are carefully selected, and receive ongoing support each year to ensure they meet our quality standards. Pre-K for All teachers and administrators are talented educators who meet the NYC Department of Education's stringent qualification requirements. Through Pre-K for All, four-year-olds citywide have the opportunity to develop the language, literacy, social-emotional, physical and cognitive skills described in the New York State Prekindergarten Foundation for the Common Core (PKFCC) learning standards.

This year, the NYC Department of Education (DOE) is providing a new tool for families – the Pre-K Quality Snapshot – to share information about each pre-K program's instructional practices and learning environment. 2.0 UNDERSTAND YOUR PRE-K OPTIONS

The DOE offers pre-K at district schools, Pre-K Centers, New York City Early Education Centers (NYCEECs), and charter schools. In each setting, your child will be in a safe learning environment with many opportunities to explore, create, and participate in engaging learning activities and to interact with other children and adults. Programs build on the strengths and diverse backgrounds children and families bring to the classroom to support all learners in gaining foundations for success in school, at home, and in life.

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2.1 Explore Pre-K Programs

There are four different types of pre-K programs offered in New York City.

District Schools: District schools are programs located within public elementary schools and overseen by the school's principal. District schools prioritize students for admission whose home address is zoned for that school, live in that school's district, or who have a sibling at that school.

Pre-K Centers: Pre-K Centers are run by NYC Department of Education staff but, unlike District Schools, they only offer pre-K. These are located either in existing district school buildings or standalone DOE sites. Pre-K Centers prioritize students for admission that live in the district where the Pre-K Center is located.

NYC Early Education Centers (NYCEECs): NYCEECs are community-based organizations that contract with the NYC Department of Education (DOE) or Administration for Children's Services (ACS) to provide pre-K. These programs are selected through a rigorous evaluation process and are supported by the DOE's Division of Early Childhood Education. NYCEECs prioritize students for admission currently enrolled in their three-year-old program, siblings in any grade at the NYCEEC, and families who receive free or subsidized social services from the organization that operates the NYCEEC.

Charter Schools: Charter schools are free public schools that are open to all NYC students. Charter schools operate independently from the NYC Department of Education. Instead, charter schools operate under a performance contract, or "charter" issued by a New York State authorizer. Charter schools are held accountable for meeting specific academic goals and often try different approaches to ensure their students meet those goals. Any student eligible for admission to a traditional district school is eligible for admission to a public charter school in NYC.

If you would like to apply for pre-K at a charter school, please contact the charter school directly to learn about the application options available and how the charter school prioritizes applicants for placement.

2.2 Visit Programs

Many programs offer tours so families can visit and learn more about them. To find out when you can visit a program, contact programs directly or visit nyc.gov/prek.

2.3 Use the Pre-K Directory

Use this directory to research your pre-K options. This directory provides a list of pre-K programs in Staten Island for the 2017-2018 school year. Programs are listed by district and a map of pre-K programs appears for each district.

As decisions are made to add new programs or extend the contract of existing providers, the list of pre-K programs available will change. For the most up-to-date program listings and information, please check the Pre-K Finder (maps.nyc.gov/prek).

2.3.1 Program Overview: Learn if the program is a District School, Pre-K Center, NYCEEC, or Charter School.

Find out if the program is accessible for individuals with limited mobility. Section 6.2 provides more information on how the DOE serves students with accessibility needs.

2.3.2 Program Information: Find out how to get in touch with the program's staff. We encourage you to reach out in person, by phone, or by email to programs that you are interested in. This section also provides information about meals served, playspace, and whether extended hours are available (late pick up and/or early drop off). Some programs may require a fee for their extended hours.

2016 Seats: See how many seats are at programs for this current school year. Programs that interest you may offer a different number of seats for September 2017 than in previous years. Check Pre-K Finder (maps.nyc.gov/prek) for the most up-to-date information regarding seat information.

Uniforms: Learn if the program requests that students wear a uniform during program hours. Pre-K for All programs may not exclude or penalize a student whose family would prefer that their child not wear a uniform. In addition, no student may be denied a uniform because of economic hardship. Please contact programs for more information about their uniform policy.

2.3.3 Programs Offered: When completing your Pre-K Application, you need to list the program code for each program you list on your application. Programs that offer a Dual Language program in addition to a non-Dual Language program will have multiple codes.

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Half-day, 5-hour, and charter school programs are not part of our application. You will not see a program code listed for them and need to contact them directly to apply.

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2.3.4 Who Got Offers in 2016? Learn which groups of students got offers last May. Many programs were able to give offers to other groups from their waitlist.

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2.3.5 Program Notes: Throughout the program listing, you may see the following program notes. Read below for explanations of each.

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- **May have income or other eligibility requirements.** This note indicates a NYCEEC program that has eligibility criteria related to household income, address of residence, government services received, and/or child care needs. Some NYCEEC pre-K programs receive Head Start and/or Child Care funding from the NYC Administration for Children's Services (ACS). Other programs may receive Head Start funding directly from the federal Administration for Children and Families' Office of Head Start.

Please contact these programs directly, before completing your application, to find out about additional eligibility requirements.

If your child is currently enrolled in one of these programs, you still must apply in order to receive an offer to attend that program (or another program). Furthermore, as your child already attends one of these programs as a three-year-old, you are strongly encouraged to apply to the same site for pre-K.

If you receive an offer to one of these programs, you will need to provide documentation verifying your eligibility in order to accept the offer (in addition to the required documents necessary to pre-register for pre-K). NYCEECs that have additional eligibility criteria in some or all classrooms are indicated in the program listings in this Pre-K Directory and on the Pre-K Finder. Be sure and look for this indicator as you review program options.

NYCEEC programs receiving this additional funding are also typically able to provide free or low-cost extended day services to eligible families. While full-day pre-K is free and available to all NYC four-year-olds, programs with ACS EarlyLearn contracts (Child Care funding) that provide extended care hours may require a fee due to the subsidized wrap-around services provided. These extended care hours are typically until 6 pm.

It is very important to contact NYCEECs that have these additional eligibility criteria **before** completing your application, in order to find out about their requirements for enrolling your child, what schedules are offered, including the first day of services, and whether there are any fees associated for subsidized services. You should only apply to these programs if you believe your family will meet their eligibility criteria, which you can check by calling the program directly. You can also check if you are eligible for ACS programs by visiting www1.nyc.gov/site/acs/early-care/eligibility.page or calling 311.

Note: If your child already attends a Head Start program, he or she will continue to remain eligible for Head Start services when he or she turns four. Similarly, families with an active Child Care subsidy case remain eligible for one year, after which they must recertify their eligibility through ACS.


- **May utilize flexible scheduling policy.** NYCEECs have some flexibility in how they choose to schedule program hours. A NYCEEC may choose to schedule program hours on weekends and/or holidays while continuing to meet the minimum requirement of 31 hours and 40 minutes of program instruction per week for full-day programs.

Some providers may also choose to schedule a short break in the middle of the day for non-program activities. These break times will not count toward DOE required operating hours. If a NYCEEC chooses to offer non-program activities during these break times, they are optional, and families who wish their children to participate must submit a written authorization. Before completing your application, please contact programs directly to learn about specific scheduling policies.

- **Single Gender Classrooms.** Some NYCEECs operate single-gender classrooms, either as part of a single-gender program or within a multi-classroom program that serves both genders. Any programs that offer single-gender classrooms are noted in this directory. Before completing your application, please contact these programs directly if you have any questions about the single-gender nature of their classrooms.
- **If your child has an IEP recommending Related Services and/or SEIT, contact the program directly for more information before applying.** This note indicates a program that only has Special Class in an Integrated Setting classrooms. Due to classroom ratio requirements, children recommended for SEIT and/or Related Services may not be able to enroll in these programs. For more information, please see section 6.1.2.
- **Magnet School.** If the program is in a magnet school, it is also noted in this section. A magnet school is a public school that offers a school-wide curriculum designed around a specific theme. While some schools have the word “magnet” in their school’s name, only those schools that received Magnet Schools Assistance Program (M.S.A.P) funding will be designated as magnet in this directory.

2.4 Use Pre-K Finder

Use Pre-K Finder (maps.nyc.gov/prek) on desktop or mobile device to find and research pre-K programs near you or in other boroughs. Check back often, starting in mid-January 2017, for newly added programs that you can add to your Pre-K Application.



2.5 List Your Program Choices

You can list up to 12 programs on your Pre-K Application. You should rank the programs on your list in order of your preferred choices.

We will try to give you an offer to the highest choice on your application. Since some programs are not big enough to accommodate all families who apply, we recommend that you list more than one program choice on your Pre-K Application. If we are not able to offer your child a placement at any of the programs listed on your application, we will offer your child a placement to a pre-K program with available seats, as close as possible to your home address.

When there are more families who apply to a program than space available, we use admissions priorities to determine who will receive an offer. As you explore your options, consider what priority you have for each program. Read more about admissions priorities in Section 4.1 and think about the following questions to understand which programs your child has a priority to attend.

- **Does your child currently attend a NYCEEC program as a three-year-old?**
- **What is your zoned school?**
- **What school district do you live in?**
- **Does your child have a sibling attending a program offering pre-K at a NYCEEC or district school?**

3.0 APPLY TO PRE-K BY FEBRUARY 24, 2017

Submit a Pre-K Application from January 17, 2017 to February 24, 2017. The application is not first-come, first-served, so explore many program options for your Pre-K Application. Make sure you submit your application online, by phone, or in person by February 24; ask for and save your receipt no matter how you apply. After completing your application, you can edit and add choices until the application deadline. If you applied online, you can edit your application using the account that you created. If you applied over the phone or in person at a Family Welcome Center, you can edit your application over the phone by calling 718-935-2067.

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4.0 RECEIVE A PRE-K OFFER IN APRIL 2017

We will send you an offer letter in the mail by late April 2017. This letter will let you know which pre-K program has a seat for your child in September 2017. If you apply online, you will also receive an email that tells you how to access your offer letter online.

Most families will receive an offer to one of the program choices listed on their Pre-K Application. The more programs you list on your application, the more likely you will receive an offer to one of the programs you prefer.

If there is no space at the programs listed on your Pre-K Application, we will offer you placement at another program with available seats, as close as possible to your home address. Your child will also be placed on the waitlist for all the programs you listed on your Pre-K Application.

4.1 Admissions Priorities

When there is not enough space at a program for all its applicants, offers are made by the NYC Department of Education based on admissions priorities. Admissions priorities are different for each pre-K program type. Below are the admissions priorities for District Schools, Pre-K Centers, and NYCEECs. Charter schools manage their own admission process; contact charter schools directly for information on their admissions process.

4.1.1 Admissions Priorities for District Schools:

1. Students residing in the zone, who will have a sibling at the school in grades K-5 in September 2017.
2. Students residing in the zone, who do not have a sibling at the school.
3. Students residing in the district, who will have a sibling at the school.
4. Students residing outside the district, who will have a sibling at the school.
5. Students residing in the district, who do not have a sibling at the school.
6. Students residing outside the district, who do not have a sibling at the school.

There are district schools without zones in New York City called non-zoned schools. For non-zoned schools, the first two admissions priorities above do not apply. District 1 (Lower East Side, Manhattan), District 7 (South Bronx) and District 23 (Brownsville, Brooklyn) are choice districts, which means they do not have any zoned schools.

A sibling is defined as a brother or sister—including half-brothers, half-sisters, stepbrothers, stepsisters, foster brothers, and foster sisters—of the applicant, who lives in the same household. For district schools, this priority only applies when the child is pre-registered or enrolled in grades K-5 at that school, and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in September 2017 at that school. This includes students enrolled in co-located District 75 programs in the same school building. You must list the older sibling's information on the application for your child to be considered for sibling priority. All sibling information is verified by the school before offers are made.

4.1.2 Admissions Priorities for Pre-K Centers:

1. Students residing in the same district as the Pre-K Center.
2. Students residing outside the district.

4.1.3 Admissions Priorities for NYCEECs:

1. Current students enrolled at the NYCEEC (for the 2016-2017 school year) in their three-year-old program.
2. Siblings of current students enrolled at the NYCEEC.
3. Students whose families currently receive free or subsidized social services from the organization operating the NYCEEC pre-K program.
4. Students who speak a language other than English that the NYCEEC specializes in serving.
5. All other students.

A sibling is defined as a brother or sister—including half-brothers, half-sisters, stepbrothers, stepsisters, foster brothers, and foster sisters—of the applicant, who lives in the same household. For NYCEECs, sibling priority can be applied regardless of what grade that sibling attends.

4.2 Waitlists

If we are unable to make your child an offer to your first choice pre-K program, we will automatically place your child on the waitlist for any programs that you listed higher on your application than the program where you receive your offer. However, your child will not be automatically added to the waitlist for programs that you listed lower than the program where you receive your offer.

For example, if you receive an offer for the program you list third on your application, you will automatically be listed on the waitlist for your first and second choice programs. If families leave either program and space becomes available for your child, the program will contact you directly.

Waitlists are sorted using the same admissions priorities that are used to determine offers. Families who live in a district school's zone and don't get an offer will be higher on the district school's waitlist than families who live outside the zone.

4.3 Round 2 Application Period

There is a Round 2 application period from April 20, 2017 to May 9, 2017. This application period will include new programs that are not part of the main application period.

You should apply in the main application period from January 17, 2017 to February 24, 2017. All families can apply in Round 2; more information will be available about Round 2 in Spring 2017.

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5.0 ACCEPT YOUR OFFER AND PRE-REGISTER BY MAY 2017

Once you get your offer letter, contact the program to arrange a time to accept your offer and pre-register. By pre-registering, you are reserving the seat for your child so he/she can attend the program in September 2017.

WHAT TO BRING FOR PRE-REGISTRATION

After you arrange a time to pre-register at the program, bring the following to accept your pre-K offer and secure your seat. Remember to pre-register by May 2017.

- Your child**
- Proof of your child's age (child's birth certificate, passport, or record of baptism)**
- Two of the documents below verifying proof of address**

- Lease agreement, deed, or mortgage statement for the residence;
- A residential utility bill (gas or electric) in the resident's name issued by a utility company (e.g., National Grid or Con Edison); must be dated within the past 60 days;
- A bill for cable television services provided to the residence; must include the name of the parent and the address of the residence and be dated within the past 60 days;
- Documentation or letter on letterhead from a federal, state, or local government agency, including the IRS, the City Housing Authority, the federal Office of Refugee Resettlement, the Human Resources Administration, or the Administration for Children's Services (ACS), or an ACS subcontractor, indicating the resident's name and address; must be dated within the past 60 days;
- A current property tax bill for the residence;
- A water bill for the residence; must be dated within the past 90 days;
- Rent receipt which includes the address of residence; must be dated within the past 60 days;
- State, city, or other government issued identification (including an IDNYC card), which has not expired and includes the address of residence;
- Income tax form for the last calendar year;
- Official NYS Driver's License or learner's permit, which has not expired;
- Official payroll documentation from an employer issued within the past 60 days such as a pay stub with home address, a form submitted for tax withholding purposes, or payroll receipt (a letter on the employer's letterhead is not adequate); must include home address and be dated within the past 60 days;
- Voter registration documents, which include the name of the parent and the address of residence;
- Unexpired membership documents based upon residency (e.g., neighborhood residents' association), which include the name of the parent and the address of residence;
- Evidence of custody of the child including, but not limited to, judicial custody orders or guardianship papers; documents must have been issued within the past 60 days and include name of student and address of residence.

Note: Students in temporary housing, as defined by McKinney-Vento, are not required to submit documentation—including address, proof of date of birth, and immunization—in order to pre-register. Programs must provisionally pre-register the student and then work with the Students in Temporary Housing liaison to obtain documentation.

6.0 MEETING YOUR CHILD'S NEEDS

The New York City Department of Education is committed to meeting the academic needs of all students.

6.1 Students with Disabilities

All families with children born in 2013, including preschool students with disabilities, may apply to pre-K programs for the 2017-2018 school year.

Many preschool students with disabilities can receive their special education services at a general education pre-K program. Some families with children who have a disability will work with their local Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) to identify a program that meets their child's needs.

6.1.1 Are You New to the Special Education Process? Preschool special education services are available for preschool students with disabilities or delays in development that affect learning. If your child is showing delays, you can contact your CPSE to request an evaluation. If your child is found eligible, the CPSE will work with you to create an Individualized Education Program (IEP).

The CPSE is responsible for coordinating the special education process for children ages 3 to 5. CPSEs work with families in the district where they reside, regardless of where children receive services or go to preschool. There are 10 CPSEs in different areas of the city. Each CPSE is part of a larger Committee on Special Education (CSE) office. To find your district, call 311 or use School Search (schools.nyc.gov/SchoolSearch).

Dual Language programs aim for a balance of children whose home language is English and children whose home language is a language other than English. 

District 31 Pre-K Programs


