Accepting students into Kindergarten

(A limited number of seats may be available in grades 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5)

P.S. 32 offers a Korean Dual Language Program beginning in Kindergarten. To be eligible for placement in Kindergarten in September 2012, students must have been born between January 1 and December 31, 2007. Students in P.S. 32's Korean Dual Language program will have the opportunity to be bilingual-speaking and writing in two languages – English and Korean. The program will consist of approximately 24 students: 12 Korean ELLs (English Language Learners) and 12 Non ELLs (English Proficient-EP students). A language assessment interview will be conducted as part of the placement process into the program. Applicants are considered for placement based on the following admissions priorities:

1. Zoned students whose siblings will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school as of September 2012.
2. Zoned students other than those with siblings in the school.
3. Students whose siblings will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school in September 2012 who are not zoned to the school but are residents of District 25.
4. Students whose siblings will be enrolled in grades K-5 in September 2012 who are residents of another district.
5. Students without siblings in the school who are residents of District 25.
6. Students without siblings in the school who are residents of another district.

Placements are made by application and a language assessment interview for Korean ELL's (English Language Learners) and Non-ELL English Proficient (EP) Students. A limited number of seats may also be available in grades 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Parents interested in having their child(ren) be part of this program must complete this application. **Completed applications must be mailed or dropped off in the main office at P.S. 32 by March 2, 2012. An Open House will be held Thursday, February 9, 2012 at 9:00 am in the school auditorium.**

It is important to understand that accepting a seat into P.S. 32's Korean Dual Language program shows a commitment that your child will attend from grade of entrance through fifth grade. In choosing to apply for this program, it is suggested that you consider the distance from your home to the school. Placement to this program does not guarantee school bus service.
