## AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION OF THE CHANCELLOR

Number: A-210

Category: STUDENTS

Subject: MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR ATTENDANCE PROGRAMS

### **I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.**

Chancellor's Regulation A-750 amends the prior version of the regulation, dated June 29, 2009, by: (1) removing references to Integrated Service Centers and School Support Organizations (p. 1, section II(C)); (2) providing that Children First Networks must provide assistance to schools to develop an attendance plan. (p. 1, section II(C)(1)); and (3) clarifying that outreach and intervention efforts must be entered into the ILOG system on ATS. (p. 2, section III(F)).
