Topic: Proposed Chancellor's Regulation A-210 (Minimum Standards for Attendance Programs)

Date of Panel Vote: January 19, 2011

Summary of Proposal

Chancellor's Regulation A-210 outlines the minimum standards for school attendance programs, including requirements for meeting state mandates, school attendance services, and overall attendance reporting and follow-up procedures. The proposed amendments (1) remove references to Integrated Service Centers and School Support Organizations; (2) provide that Children First Networks must provide assistance to schools to develop an attendance plan; and (3) clarify that outreach and intervention efforts must be entered into the ILOG system on ATS.

Summary of Issues Raised in Written and Oral Comments and Significant Alternatives Suggested

No public comments were received regarding this proposal.

Analysis of Issues Raised, Significant Alternatives Proposed and Changes Made to the Proposal

The DOE has made no changes to the proposed regulation. The regulation will be presented to the Panel for Educational Policy as posted.
