Topic: Proposed Chancellor's Regulation A-449 (Safety Transfers)

Date of Panel Vote: January 19, 2011

Summary of Proposal

Chancellor's Regulation A-449 sets forth the procedures for granting safety transfers (1) when students are victims of a violent criminal offense on school property; and (2) in other situations, when it is determined that a student's continued presence in the school is unsafe for the student. The proposed amendment changes references to the Director of Student Suspensions at the Integrated Service Center/Director of Safety and Suspensions at the Children First Network to the Borough Director of Suspensions.

Summary of Issues Raised in Written and Oral Comments and Significant Alternatives Suggested

No public comments were received regarding this proposal.

Analysis of Issues Raised, Significant Alternatives Proposed and Changes Made to the Proposal

The DOE has made no changes to the proposed regulation. The regulation will be presented to the Panel for Educational Policy as posted.
