Topic: Proposed Chancellor's Regulation A-750 (Child Abuse)

Date of Panel Vote: January 19, 2011

Summary of Proposal

New York State's Social Services Law commonly called The Child Protective Services Law, mandates that school personnel report all cases of suspected child abuse and neglect directly to the State Central Register. Chancellor's Regulation A-750 sets forth the obligations of school personnel to report and cooperate with investigations conducted by child protective service workers. The proposed amendments: (1) reflect the current Department of Education organization including Children First Networks; (2) update the website address for the On-line Occurrence Reporting System; and (3) revise the website address for the LDSS 2221-A form.

Summary of Issues Raised in Written and Oral Comments and Significant Alternatives Suggested

No public comments were received regarding this proposal.

Analysis of Issues Raised, Significant Alternatives Proposed and Changes Made to the Proposal

The DOE has made no changes to the proposed regulation. The regulation will be presented to the Panel for Educational Policy as posted.
