Topic: Proposed Chancellor's Regulation A-860 (Naming And Renaming A New York City Public School Or A Particular Facility Within A New York City Public School)

Date of Panel Vote: January 19, 2011

Summary of Proposal

Chancellor's Regulation A-860 provides the rules and procedures that must be followed for the naming and renaming of public schools. It also specifies the rules and procedures to name designated areas of a public school in honor of a donor or grantor or in honor of a deceased person special to the local school community. The proposed amendments reflect the Department of Education's current organization including changing the Office of Portfolio Development to the Division of Portfolio Planning and the Office of Engagement and Advocacy ("OFEA") to the Office of Family Information and Action ("OFIA").

Summary of Issues Raised in Written and Oral Comments and Significant Alternatives Suggested

No public comments were received regarding this proposal.

Analysis of Issues Raised, Significant Alternatives Proposed and Changes Made to the Proposal

The DOE has made no changes to the proposed regulation. The regulation will be presented to the Panel for Educational Policy as posted.
