Kings Collegiate seeks to revise its charter to enable students in grades 9-12 from Excellence Boys Charter School to join the co-located high school. Co-locating students in grades 9-12 from all three schools will create economies of scale, enabling the schools to offer diverse educational and extracurricular opportunities that are integral to achieving the schools' mission of preparing each student for college.
