

Resolution Regarding Approval of the Proposed Revision of the Building Utilization Plan for Building K211 Describing the Co-location of Leadership Preparatory Charter School 4 (84KTBD) with I.S. 211 John Wilson (18K211) Beginning in 2013-2014

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Law § 2853(3)(a-3)(4) the Panel for Educational Policy (“Panel”) has the power to approve revisions to Building Utilization Plans describing the allocation of space in school buildings in which one or more public charter schools are co-located with one or more district schools; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2013, the Department of Education posted a proposed revised Building Utilization Plan for building K211, located at 1001 East 100 Street, Brooklyn, NY 11236, in Community School District 18 (the “Proposed Revised BUP”); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law §§ 2590-b(1)(c), notice and a brief description of the Proposed Revised BUP was circulated to all community superintendents, community district education councils, community boards, and school based management teams at least ten business days in advance of the Panel meeting at which the Proposed Revised BUP came before the Panel for a vote; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel for Educational Policy approve the Proposed Revised BUP; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Panel for Educational Policy to approve the Proposed Revised BUP; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law 2853(3)(a-3)(4) the Panel for Educational Policy hereby approves the proposed revision of the Building Utilization Plan for building K211 describing the co-location of Leadership Preparatory Charter School 4 (84KTBD) with I.S. 211 John Wilson (18K211) beginning in 2013-2014.
