10 Words or Less Scholarship- \$500 award. Anyone who is between the ages of 14-25 who will be attending school in the Fall of 2013. Ascend Educational Fund – Provides two-year or four-year college scholarships to promising immigrant students in New York City, who were either born outside the US or have two parents born outside the U.S. in the range of \$2,500-\$20,000. Association of Black Educators of New York, Inc. (ABENY, INC.)

An 8 ½ x 11 typewritten composition, four letters of recommendation (2 of which must be from school personnel), resume which includes extra-curricular activities, community and school service. **Postmark deadline: April 30, 2013. Come to the College Office for an application.**

BP – Amoco Community Scholarship - \$2,000 scholarships to graduating seniors planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college full time, legally reside in NY, possess a 3.0 (80% avg.), demonstrate financial need; essay required. Please visit www.bpscholarships.com for details and to apply. **Deadline to College Office: May 2, 2013.**

Mid Island Rotary Club

2008 Kathleen Kiernan Memorial Scholarship – eligible seniors: must have an 85 overall avg., demonstrate service to school and/or community, must attend a post secondary school (college or trade school). Resume required. See Mrs. Watkins to be nominated. **Deadline: April 11, 2013.**

Milton Fisher Scholarship – A four year scholarship of up to \$5,000 per year for four years. For seniors who display evidence of innovative and creative problem solving. Essay required. Staten Island Achieve –Island-Wide Achieve Award - \$1,000-\$2,500 Annual Scholarships – Open to seniors who have maintained at least an 85 average, and have demonstrated strong work ethic (in school or out) and/or have overcome economic or personal hardship. Pick up an application in B233. **Deadline: March 25, 2010.**

Staten Island Achieve-Judy Ryan Scholar Athlete Award - \$5,000 Annual Scholarship – Open to seniors who have competed in any team sport on the varsity level, maintained at least an 85 average. Pick up an application in the College Office, Rm. B233. **Deadline: March 25, 2010.**

The Stephanie Marie Burgos Scholarship - \$2,000, senior in good standing at a NYC public high school, min. 80% avg., accepted by at least one accredited four-year college, demonstrated financial need, overcame social or emotional difficulties, possess an interest in the fine or communication arts, personal statement, 2 ltrs. Of recommendation. Please come to the College Office, Rm. B233 for an application. **Deadline: April 5, 2013.**

The Whitney M. Young Jr. Memorial Scholarship – Must be a NYC resident, of African-American, Latino, Asian, Or Native American background, current high school graduate or recipient of a GED, accepted as a full time and first term matriculated freshman at an accredited college or university, 80 avg. or above or a GED score of 2800. 500 word essay.
