RESOLUTION # 023

Whereas, the obtaining of District 32 necessitates the carving of a zone from which to draw students; and

Whereas, the DOE submitted a draft proposal creating a zone for District 32;

Whereas, Community District Education Council 32 (subsequently referred to as "CEC32") has reached out to the impacted by means of meetings, electronic and social media; and

Whereas, CEC32 has worked collaboratively with the DOE in an effort to accommodate the needs of the involved school communities; and

Whereas, CEC32 believes that the plan now submitted by District 32 Community Superintendent, Mrs. Lillian Druck, represents the best available compromise between all parties; and

Whereas, CEC32, in collaboration with the DOE, will monitor the implementation of this plan and its impact upon the community.

Therefore Be It Resolved that CEC32 accepts and approves the following zoning plan for District 32 as submitted by Community Superintendent, Mrs. Lillian Druck:

1. Goals of the proposal: The Office of Portfolio Management, the community Superintendent, and the Office of Student Enrollment propose zoning changes for the current elementary school zones of P.S. 123, P.S. 86, P.S. 116, and P.S. 376 in order to rezone District 32 residents that are currently zoned to District 24 in Queens.
 - a. Rezoning District 32 residents to District 32 elementary Schools will help alleviate the extreme overcrowding conditions in District 24 elementary schools and will accommodate students within their own residential district and borough.
2. Schools affected by the proposal: P.S. 123, P.S. 86, P.S. 116, and P.S. 376
3. Effective date for initial implementation: This plan is being implemented for September 2013, inclusive of the 2013-2014 admissions process.

4. Projected number of kindergarten students in each zone to be moved between all affected school zones:

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6. A complete description of all zone line changes:

a. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 123 zone:

- Begin at southeast corner of Flushing Avenue and Cypress Avenue, then
- East on Cypress Avenue to Green Avenue, then
- South on Greene Avenue (not including any street addresses) to St. Nicholas Avenue, then
- West on St. Nicholas Avenue (including all street addresses) to Himrod Street, then
- South on Himrod Street (not including any street addresses) to Irving Avenue, then
- West on Irving Avenue (not including any street addresses) to Stockholm Street, then
- South on Stockholm Street (not including any street addresses) to Knickerbocker Avenue, then
- West on Knickerbocker Avenue to Jefferson Street, then
- North on Jefferson Street (not including any street addresses) to Irving Avenue, then
- West on Irving Avenue to Flushing Avenue, then
- North on Flushing Avenue to Steward Avenue, then
- North on Stewart Avenue (including all street addresses) to Johnson Avenue, then
- East on Johnson Avenue to Flushing Avenue (the point of origin).

b. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 86 zone:

- Begin at southeast corner of Cypress Avenue and Green Avenue, then
- West on Cypress Avenue to Menahan Street, then
- South on Menahan Street to St. Nicholas Avenue, then
- West on St. Nicholas Avenue (including all street addresses) to Bleeker Street, then
- South on Bleeker Street to Myrtle Avenue, then
- West on Myrtle Avenue to Knickerbocker Avenue, then
- West on Knickerbocker Avenue (including all street addresses) to Himrod Street, then
- North on Himrod Street (not including any street addresses) to Irving Avenue, then
- North on Himrod Street (including all street addresses) to St. Nicholas Avenue, then
- East on St. Nicholas Avenue (not including any street addresses) to Greene Avenue, then
- North on Greene Avenue (including all street addresses) to Cypress Avenue (the point of origin).

c. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 16 zone:

- Begin at southeast corner of Bleeker Street and St. Nicholas Avenue, then
- East on St. Nicholas Avenue (not including any street addresses to Menahan Street), then
- East on St. Nicholas Avenue (including all street addresses) to Gates Avenue, then
- South on Gates Avenue to Knickerbocker Avenue, then
- West on Knickerbocker Avenue to Linden Street, then

- South on Linden Street to Wilson Avenue, then
- West on Wilson Avenue (not including any street addresses) to Grove Street, then
- West on Wilson Avenue to Menahan Street, then
- North on Menahan Street to Myrtle Avenue, then
- West on Myrtle Avenue to Bleecker Street, then
- North on Bleecker Street to St. Nicholas Avenue (the point of origin).

d. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 376 zone:

- Begin at southeast corner of Stockholm Street and Irving Avenue, then
- East on Irving Avenue (including all street addresses) to Himrod Street, then
- South on Himrod Street (including all street addresses) to Knickerbocker Avenue, then
- East on Knickerbocker Avenue (not including any street addresses) to Myrtle Avenue, then
- East on Myrtle Avenue to Menahan Street, then
- South on Menahan Street to Wilson Avenue, then
- West on Wilson Avenue (including all street addresses) to Stockholm Street, then
- North on Stockholm Street to Knickerbocker Avenue, then
- North on Stockholm Street (including all street addresses) to Irving Avenue (the point of origin).

7. A statement of how students will be admitted to the affected schools: The proposed changes would impact only incoming kindergarten or students that are new to the system. All currently enrolled students may remain in their school. As stated in chancellor's regulation A-101, Kindergarten students would be admitted in the following order of priority:

- First Priority. Zoned students with verified siblings who will be enrolled in grades 1-5 in the school as of September 2013.
- Second Priority. Zoned students without siblings applying to the zoned school
- Third Priority. Non- zoned students with verified siblings who will be enrolled in grades 1- 5 in the school as of September 2013:
 - a. Within district first, then
 - b. Out of district
- Fourth Priority. Non-zoned students without siblings:
 - a. Within district first, then
 - b. Out of district

*Current in-zone siblings who would be zoned out based on the proposed line will be grandfathered as an in-zone sibling.
