Supplies needed for note-taking and storage of papers/documents are listed below. You have the option to purchase the supplies listed in column choice one or choice two depending on your learning style.

Supplies you will need for each class on a daily basis:

- loose-leaf
- thumb drive

- a scientific calculator (not a graphing calculator)
 - o Texas instrument model #TI 30XIIS is recommended (approximate cost \$10)
- a pencil case bag with zipper (not a box) containing the following
 - o sharpened pencils
 - o black or blue pens
 - o a small ruler with metric measurements
 - o a small protractor
 - o large pink eraser
 - o a pencil sharpener, in its own case
 - o a dry erase marker
 - o a highlighter
 - o a small pair of scissors

Homeroom Supplies to be given to your homeroom teacher to be kept in class. Please do not bring these in on the first day of school; your homeroom teacher will instruct you of when to bring these in. Thank you!

Some of the required supplies will be collected to be stored in the art room as community supplies. These are general supplies that are used by all students often and will be provided to your child when needed. Community supplies are indicated in the bulleted list below by (C). Other supplies are individual supplies that the student is responsible for maintaining and bringing to each art class. They are indicated in the list below by (I).

- 1 drawing pencil set (preferred) or each of the following drawing pencils: 4H, 2H, 2B, 4B (I)
- 1 standard looseleaf folder
- white copy paper inserted in the folder (a nice sized chunk of paper, at least 50 sheets)
- 10 standard, yellow, #2 pencils (C)
- 2 hand-held pencil sharpeners; all metal sharpener preferred (I)
- 1 kneaded eraser (I)
- 2 pink or white block erasers (I)
- 1 compass or other circle-drawing tool (I)
- 2 rolls of paper towels (C)
- 1 large pack/ container of baby wipes (not Lysol wipes or hand sanitizer please) (C)
- 1 box of tissues (C)

* At various times in the school year, students may be asked to voluntarily bring in other supplies, such as paper plates, newspaper, etc...

* It is recommended that all student art supplies be stored and carried in a small, durable pouch or container
