The following colleges/universities/institutions are offering these scholarship opportunities:

10 Words or Less Scholarship- \$500 award. Anyone who is between the ages of 14-25 who will be attending school in the Fall of 2013. A student must answer the question on the sponsor's website in 10 words or less. Applications can be found by going to: <http://www.facebook.com/myscholarships>. **Deadline: April 1, 2013.**

Association of Black Educators of New York, Inc. (ABENY, INC.)

An 8 ½ x 11 typewritten composition, four letters of recommendation (2 of which must be from school personnel), resume which includes extra-curricular activities, community and school service. **Postmark deadline: April 30, 2013. Come to the College Office for an application.**

The Bayway Complex Community Advisory Panel (CAP)

Eligibility – Applications will be limited to High School Seniors living in Linden, Elizabeth, Rahway, or Staten Island. Applications that are not typed will not be considered. Scholarship will be awarded to applicants from the following areas: Industrial, Process Technology, or Engineering. Seniors who will be pursuing a degree in the Industrial, Process Technology or Engineering fields – attendance, extra-curricular activities and community service will be considered. Applications must be computer generated or typed. Come to the College Office for more information.

Postmark Deadline: March 22, 2013.

The Brooklyn Chapter of Jack and Jill of America - \$4,000 award to African American students in need, 85 avg or better, Students must enroll in accredited four year college, must be a graduating high school senior and Brooklyn or Staten Island resident. Student must demonstrate exemplary achievement in Scholarship, Leadership and Service in the community. Typed personal statement required. Come to the College Office, Rm. B233 for an application.

Postmark Deadline: March 15, 2013.

Buick Achievers Scholarship Program – Must be high school senior, plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited four-year college, plan to major in a specified course of study that focuses on Engineering/Technology or select Design and Business related programs of study (see list of eligible majors on website). Be U.S. citizens and have permanent residence in the United States or Puerto Rico. Scholarship recipients are selected based on the following: Academic achievement 85+ avg., financial need, participation and leadership in community and school activities, work experience.
