

Resolution Regarding Approval of the Proposed Grade Truncation of P.S. 104 The Bays Water School (27Q104) to a K-5 School

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law § 2590-h(2-a), the Chancellor prepared an educational impact statement, initially published and filed on October 1, 2010, on the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104 The Bays Water School (27Q104) (“P.S. 104”) to a K-5 school, and subsequently published an amended educational impact statement on the proposal on November 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g(8), the Panel for Educational Policy (“Panel”) undertook a public review process for review and comment on the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104; and

WHEREAS, such review process included notice of the proposal via the New York City Department of Education’s (the “Department”) internet website and circulation of the notice of the proposal to all community superintendents, community district education councils, community boards, and school based management teams; and

WHEREAS, such notice further included: a) a description of the purpose and substance of the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104; b) information regarding where the full text of the proposal could be obtained; c) the name, office, address, email and telephone number of the Department representative from whom information concerning the proposal could be obtained; d) the date, time, and place of any hearing on the proposal; e) the date, time and place of the meeting of the Panel at which the Panel will vote on the proposal; and f) information on how to submit written or oral comments regarding the proposal; and

WHEREAS, such notice and public review process commenced on October 1, 2010, at least forty-five days in advance of the November 16, 2010 meeting of the Panel at which the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104 came before the Panel for a vote; and

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2010, the Department published an amended educational impact statement for the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104, which clarifies data concerning the percentage of P.S. 104 students who are eligible for free or reduced price meals, but which does not revise or modify the proposal itself; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law § 2590-h(2-a)(d-1), the Chancellor has held a joint public hearing on the proposal with the District 27 Community Education Council and the impacted school leadership team at which all interested parties had an opportunity to present comments or concerns on the proposal; and

WHEREAS, following the public review and comment period, the Panel made available to the public, including via the Department’s internet web site, an assessment of all public comments concerning the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104; and

WHEREAS, the assessment of public comments included a summary and analysis of the issues raised and any significant suggested alternatives; a statement of the reasons why any significant alternatives were not incorporated into the proposal; a description of any changes to the proposal

as a result of the public comments; and information regarding where the full text of any approved proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104 may be obtained; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel for Educational Policy approve the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Panel for Educational Policy to approve the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g, the Panel for Educational Policy hereby approves the proposed grade truncation of P.S. 104 The Bays Water School (27Q104) to a K-5 school.
