Proposed Charter Revision	Achievement First Brownsville Charter School, located in CSD 23, has applied for a charter extension for the period January 15, 2013 through July 31, 2013 (to complete the current school year) and thereafter for a full-term charter renewal of five years commencing on August 1, 2013. According to the renewal application, the school plans to serve 738 students in grades K-8 in the renewal charter term.
