# Education and Career Training

Phoenix Houses of New York and the New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE) partner to offer dynamic education programming at these locations:

## Phoenix House Academy of Westchester, Shrub Oak, NY

Residential Treatment Services, High School, Career and Technical Education (CTE), and GED

The Academy serves boys and girls between 14 and 20.5 years old who are Phoenix House residents. Teachers, counselors, and medical staff work to create an encouraging environment, as students live and study in a structured community, learning responsibility. The Academy offers:

- Individualized treatment services
- Individual and group counseling
- Family therapy
- Tutoring
- Academic interventions for repeat 8th graders
- High school classes and Regents exams
- GED preparation classes
- CTE courses at CoOp Tech
- NFTE Entrepreneurship
- Outdoor recreation
- Agriculture program
- Gym and exercise room
- Carpentry and electrical training

Other vocational training is offered at CoOp Tech in Manhattan. Transportation provided.

## Phoenix House Career Academy, Brooklyn, NY

Residential Treatment Services, High School, Career and Technical Education (CTE), and GED

Clients from Phoenix House's New York City programs as well as day students (16-22 years old) from the community are eligible to attend vocational training and/or GED classes at our Career Academy. In partnership with CoOp Tech, the Academy provides instruction in a variety of career programs:

- Building Maintenance
- Cosmetology
- Culinary Class
- GED preparation classes

Our model is one of Brooklyn's most successful vocational programs; we teach students the skills necessary to thrive in the workplace and achieve their personal and professional goals.

## Phoenix House Jack Aron Center, New York, NY

IMPACT and GED

For more than 30 years, Phoenix House's IMPACT (Intervention Moves Parents and Children Together) has helped young people (ages 13-24) and families turn their lives around.

The Center offers:

- Outpatient treatment
- After-school programs
- Individual, group, and family counseling
- Sober recreational activities
- Paid internship
- GED preparation classes
- Weekly meetings with NYCDOE staff for former Phoenix House Academy of Westchester students returning to home high schools
