In addition, Madiba scholars enjoy visits from experts in many professions, annual college tours, foreign languages, and leadership classes and opportunities. Our scholars also receive embedded individualized academic support in cerebral diversity classes, and a no-cost after school program. Our scholars benefit from embedded social workers and guidance counselors to support them; we focus on the whole child. Madiba Prep is the first NYC school whose name was inspired by Nelson Mandela.
