## Resolution & 72 – Zoning of P330Q and Rezoning of PS143Q

Whereas the New York City Department of Education's Division of Portfolio Planning has deemed PS 143 in Corona to be overcrowded

Whereas, in May 2012, the Division of Portfolio Planning created a zoning proposal that would shift future kindergarten and newly registered students from PS 143 to newly zoned PS 330 as follows:

addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 330 elementary school zone:

- Begin at southeast corner of Astoria Boulevard and 106th Street, then
- East on Astoria Boulevard, then
- South on Grand Central Parkway, then
- West on 34th Avenue, then
- North on 104th Street, then
- West on Northern Boulevard, then
- North on 102nd Street, then
- East on 32nd Avenue, then
- North on 106th Street to Astoria Boulevard (the point of origin)

**b.** The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 143 elementary school zone:

- Begin at the southeast corner of 34th Avenue and 103rd Street, then
- East on 34th Avenue, then
- South on Grand Central Parkway, then
- West on 45th Avenue, then
- North on 114th Street, then

- West on Roosevelt Avenue, then
- North on 108th Street, then
- West on 38th Avenue, then
- North on 104th Street, then
- West on 35th Avenue, then
- North on 103rd Street to 34th Avenue (the point of origin).

Be it resolved that the CEC District 24 agrees with and fully supports the proposed zoning lines for PS 330 and the rezoning of PS 143 for the 2013/2014 school year.
