- Demonstrate the use of teaching literacy within the content area of social studies
- Foster the development of Social Studies skills, including research, writing, chronology, image analysis, and the use of primary and secondary sources.
- Cognizant of District 75 Applied Learning/Social Studies Initiatives
- Demonstrate expertise in multiple types of technology such as Smart Board and Microsoft Office Programs, including iMovie, iPhoto, iPad
- Demonstrate best practices and knowledge of students with special needs, UDL, Backward Design in order to plan Units of Study in K-12 Social Studies classrooms
- Demonstrate success in collaboratively working with other staff on programmatic issues
