

Amended Notice of Joint Public Hearing

Proposal: The Proposed Grade Truncation of P.S. 96 (27Q096) to a K-5 School

The DOE is proposing to implement a “grade truncation” meaning that P.S. 96 would no longer enroll sixth grade students after the current 2011-2012 school year. If this proposal is approved, at the close of the 2011-2012 school year, all fifth and sixth grade students who meet promotional standards would graduate from P.S. 96 and participate in the Middle School Choice Process. On October 3, 2011, the New York City Department of Education (“DOE”) issued an Educational Impact Statement (“EIS”) describing a proposal to truncate P.S. 96. The DOE has now published an amended EIS, which corrects the percentage of students receiving integrated co-teaching (“ICT”) or self-contained (“SC”) services.
