Topic: Aggregation of Community School District Budgets

Date of Panel Vote: September 15, 2010

### **Summary of Proposed Item**

Pursuant to Section 2590-r of the New York State Education Law, the Panel for Educational Policy (the “Panel”), must approve an aggregation of the community school district budgets, as modified and approved by the chancellor, together with a proposed budget for the administrative expenditures of the city board and the chancellor (the “Aggregated Budget”). The Aggregated Budget represents a consolidation of the school-based budgets created pursuant to Chancellor’s Regulation B-801. The Aggregated Budget was previously approved on a temporary, emergency basis by the Panel, and now comes before the Panel for final approval.

### **Summary of Issues Raised and Significant Alternatives Proposed**

No written or oral comments regarding the Aggregated Budget were received during the public review period and no significant alternatives have been suggested.

### **Analysis of Issues Raised, Significant Alternatives Proposed and Changes Made to the Proposal**

The DOE has made no changes to the Aggregated Budget. The Aggregated Budget thus will be presented to the Panel as it is posted.
