
# Parent and teacher participation rose dramatically


# All boroughs showed steady gains in parent response rates

# Parent response rates increased in most districts


Parent Response Rate 2007, 2008, AND 2009


# Schools with younger students continue to have higher parent response rates



\*Grade level response rates are averages of schools' response rates. The Citywide response rate is the percent of all parents that completed the survey.




2007 Elementary School





# High 2008 Progress Report and Quality Review scores correlate with high 2009 parent response rates






# Parent and teacher survey scores increased




# Student satisfaction showed slight change




# Parent responses showed consistent increase in satisfaction




# Teachers also reported higher levels of satisfaction
