## What services are available to immigrant children and families?

- ▶ **Child and Family Welfare** – Preventive services, child care and early education, homelessness prevention, and more.
- ▶ **Donations and Volunteering**
- ▶ **Education** – Public school enrollment, English Language Learners programs, adult education, and after school and community services.
- ▶ **Health Services** – Public health insurance for all children, free and low-cost healthcare clinics, immunization, and mental health services.
- ▶ **Legal Services** – Free and low-cost referrals for help with immigration law, family law, and criminal law.

## Are these services available regardless of immigration status?

Yes.

City employees will not ask about immigration status unless it is necessary to determine eligibility for a service or benefit.
