<b>Proposed Charter Revision</b>	Brooklyn Prospect Charter School currently serves approximately 344 students in grades 6-9, and seeks to change its waitlist policy to address the needs of at-risk “over the counter” students. Over the counter students are students that re no eligible to participate in charter school lotteries or other New York City Department of Education (“NYCDOE”) choice programs due to residency restrictions at the time of the lottery. Brooklyn Prospect will place such over the counter students at the top of the waitlist. Note that the charter school’s definition of “over the counter” does not match the Chancellor’s Regulations definition.
