1 DAY TRAINING – EMPOWERING STUDENTS TO MOVE FROM BYSTANDERS TO ALLIES

A full day training is available on a new K-5 or 6-12 curriculum module, "*Fostering Respect for All: Empowering Students to Move From Bystanders to Allies.*" Schools may use this student engagement module as a prevention strategy, an intervention strategy or both. The module is designed so that the sequential lessons can be used either in "pull out" small group workshops that engage a group of 10-15 students who have been selected for inclusion in a workshop to empower them to become allies or for "push in" full class instruction.
