

## Provider Assignment System

### Awaiting Contract Agency Assignment Status Values



The Assignment Status for a mandate in Provider Assignment will vary depending on the progress of the mandate through the provider assignment process. This document explains what each Assignment Status value means on the **Awaiting Contract Agency** tab.

Assignment Status	Description
<b>Requested Contract Agency</b>	The mandate requires a search for a primary contract agency.
<b>Awaiting Contract Agency Provider</b>	A Primary Contract Agency was found for the mandate. The mandate is awaiting the assignment of a provider by the agency supervisor.
<b>Awaiting Contract Agency Provider Confirmation</b>	If a mandate changes during the school year as a result of an Annual or Reevaluation, the agency provider will need to confirm their continued assignment to the mandate in Provider Assignment.
<b>Primary Contract Agency Does Not Exist</b>	A search for a primary contract agency was unsuccessful for the mandate.
<b>Contract Agency Timeout</b>	The primary contract agency supervisor did not assign a provider to the mandate before the close of business on the fifth school day after receiving notification.
<b>Contract Agency Rejected</b>	The primary contract agency rejected the case.
<b>Pending Contract Agency Responses</b>	The secondary/tertiary bidding process has commenced. The agency supervisors have until close of business on the <i>Response Due Date</i> to indicate a provider.
<b>Awaiting First Attend</b>	A primary contract agency provider is assigned to the mandate, or a secondary / tertiary agency has been awarded the bid; and the mandate is awaiting entry of a first attend date.
<b>Reason for Delay Needed</b>	A reason is needed for a delay in the entry of a First Attend Date.
<b>Bidding Closed / Ready to Award</b>	The secondary/tertiary bidding process has closed for this mandate. DOE staff should review the submitted bids and award the mandate to an agency.
