

**Resolution Regarding Approval of the Proposed Temporary
Co-location of a New School, P.S. 267, with P.S. 158 in School Building M158 through the
2011-2012 School Year**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law 2590-h(2-a), the Chancellor has prepared an educational impact statement on the proposal to temporarily co-locate P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law 2590-h(2-a), the Chancellor has held a joint public hearing on the proposal with the District 2 Community Education Council and the school leadership teams at which all interested parties had an opportunity to present comments or concerns on the proposal; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g(8), the Panel for Educational Policy undertook a public review process for review and comment on the proposed temporary co-location of P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year; and

WHEREAS, such review process included notice of the proposal via the Department of Education's internet website and circulation of the notice of the proposal to all community superintendents, community district education councils, community boards, and school based management teams; and

WHEREAS, such notice further included: a) a description of the purpose and substance of the proposal to temporarily co-locate P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year; b) information regarding where the full text of the proposal could be obtained; (c) the name, office, address, email and telephone number of the Department of Education representative from whom information concerning the proposal could be obtained; d) the date, time, and place of any hearing on the proposal; e) the date, time and place of the meeting of the Panel at which the Panel will vote on the proposal; and f) information on how to submit written or oral comments regarding the proposal; and

WHEREAS, such notice and public review process commenced on February 2, 2010, at least forty-five days in advance of the March 23, 2010 meeting of the Panel at which the proposed co-location came before the Panel for a vote; and

WHEREAS, following the public review and comment period, the Panel made available to the public, including via the Department of Education's internet web site, an assessment of all public comments concerning the proposed temporary co-location of P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year; and

WHEREAS, the assessment of public comments included a summary and analysis of the issues raised and any significant suggested alternatives; a statement of the reasons why any significant alternatives were not incorporated into the proposal; a description of any changes to the proposal as a result of the public comments; and information regarding where the full text of any approved

temporary co-location of P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year may be obtained; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel for Educational Policy approve the proposal to temporarily co-locate P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year; and

WHEREAS, the temporary co-location of P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year is necessary to provide additional elementary capacity in the Upper East Side neighborhood of District 2; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Panel for Educational Policy to temporarily co-locate P.S. 267, and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g, the Panel for Educational Policy hereby approves the proposal to temporarily co-locate P.S. 267 and P.S. 158 in school building M158 through the 2011-2012 school year.
