Educational Impact Statement

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

In the 2010-2011 school year, Carl C. Icahn Charter School IV (84X496, "Icahn IV"), an existing school that serves students in grades K-2, will continue its temporary siting in the James Monroe High School Campus Annex, school building X423 ("X423"), which is located at 1551 East 172nd Street, in Community School District 12 ("District 12"). X423 is a recently constructed facility, opened in 2009, with a capacity of 1,144 that currently houses Icahn IV, Mott Hall V (12X242, "Mott Hall V"), and The Cinema School (12X478, "Cinema School").

Icahn IV opened in September 2009 and has since been located in X423. The school was scheduled to move to a private facility prior to the 2010-2011 school year, but because the original plans for a private facility did not come to fruition in time, Icahn IV will continue to be housed temporarily at X423 for an additional school year.

X423 was built to accommodate both a 6-12 school and a 9-12 school. Mott Hall V will serve grades 6-9 next year and The Cinema School will serve grades 9-10. Therefore, X423 has sufficient space for Icahn IV to remain for an additional school year and phase-in another grade. X423 has sufficient space for Icahn IV, The Cinema School and Mott Hall V to operate at full organizational capacity in the 2010-2011 school year.

Given the capacity of X423 of 1,144, the total combined enrollment of Icahn IV, Mott Hall V, and The Cinema School of 464, and the fact that there is also a District 75 program located in the building, the approximate utilization of X423 is just under 50%. This proposal addresses the need to continue to offer high quality options for students in District 12.
