REGULATION OF THE CHANCELLOR

Number: A-812
Category: STUDENTS
Subject: COMPETITIVE FOODS

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

Chancellor's Regulation A-812 supersedes the prior version of the regulation, dated June 29, 2009. The revised regulation sets forth rules for student, school, and PTA fundraising activity that involves the sale of food items. Modifications have been made to reflect that students can sell any approved food items at any time during the school day, but not in the cafeteria. In addition, PTAs can hold a monthly fundraiser with non-approved foods during the day as long as it occurs outside of the cafeteria and complies with Chancellor's Regulation A-610 and Chancellor's Regulation A-660. Finally, the regulation establishes that the Chancellor reserves the right to waive any provision of the regulation if he determines it to be in the best interests of the school system.
