<p>Success Academy Charter Schools – NYC, an existing not-for-profit charter school education corporation, located at 310 Lenox Avenue, 2nd Floor, New York, NY 10027, currently has the authority to operate: Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 1; Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 2; Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 3; Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 4; Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 5; Success Academy Charter School – Union Square; Success Academy Charter School – Hell’s Kitchen; Success Academy Charter School – Bronx 3; Success Academy Charter School – Fort Greene; Success Academy Charter School – Prospect Heights; Success Academy Charter School – Crown Heights; Success Academy Charter School – New York 1; Success Academy Charter School – New York 2; Success Academy Charter School – New York 3; Success Academy Charter School – New York 4; Success Academy Charter School – New York 5; and Success Academy Charter School – New York 6.</p> <p>The education Corporation proposes to merge with the above named education corporation: Success Academy Charter School—Upper West. If the merger is approved, Success Academy Charter Schools – NYC would be the successor education corporation. The proposed merger would be effective July 1, 2014, or as soon thereafter as practicable at the close of a fiscal quarter. Each education corporation other than Success Academy Charter Schools – NYC seeks a revision to its charter to permit it to merge with that education corporation. Success Academy Charter Schools – NYC seeks permission to merge with each other education corporation.</p>
