

Resolution Regarding Approval of the Proposed Revision of the Building Utilization Plan For the Co-location of Citizens of the World Charter School New York 2 (84KTBD) with P.S. 221 Toussaint L'Ouverture (17K221) in building K221 and building K892

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Law § 2853(3)(a-3)(4) the Panel for Educational Policy (“Panel”) has the power to approve revisions to Building Utilization Plans describing the allocation of space in school buildings in which one or more public charter schools are co-located with one or more district schools; and

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2013, the Department of Education posted a proposed revised Building Utilization Plan for building K221 and K892, located at 791 Empire Boulevard, Brooklyn, NY 11213, in Community School District 17 (the “Proposed Revised BUP”); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law §§ 2590-b(1)(c), notice and a brief description of the Proposed Revised BUP was circulated to all community superintendents, community district education councils, community boards, and school based management teams at least ten business days in advance of the Panel meeting at which the Proposed Revised BUP came before the Panel for a vote; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel for Educational Policy approve the Proposed Revised BUP; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Panel for Educational Policy to approve the Proposed Revised BUP; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law § 2853(3)(a-3)(4), the Panel for Educational Policy hereby approves the proposed revision of the Building Utilization Plan for the co-location of Citizens of the World Charter School New York 2 (84KTBD) with P.S. 221 Toussaint L'Ouverture (17K221) in building K221 and building K892.
