

**Resolution Regarding Approval of the
Proposed Re-Siting of P.S. 204X**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law 2590-h(2-a), the Chancellor has prepared an educational impact statement on the proposal to re-site P.S. 204X to school building X338, located at 1740 Macombs Road, Bronx; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law 2590-h(2-a), the Chancellor has held a joint public hearing on the proposal with the District 9 Community Education Council and the school leadership team at which all interested parties had an opportunity to present comments or concerns on the proposal; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g(8), the Panel for Educational Policy undertook a public review process for review and comment on the proposed re-siting of P.S. 204X from its current location to school building X338; and

WHEREAS, such review process included notice of the proposal via the Department of Education's internet website and circulation of the notice of proposal to all community superintendents, community district education councils, community boards, and school based management teams; and

WHEREAS, such notice further included: a) a description of the purpose and substance of the proposal to re-site P.S. 204X; b) information regarding where the full text of the proposal could be obtained; (c) the name, office, address, email and telephone number of the Department of Education representative from whom information concerning the proposed re-siting could be obtained; d) the date, time and place of the meeting of the Panel at which the Panel will vote on the proposed re-siting; and e) information on how to submit written or oral comments regarding the proposed re-siting; and

WHEREAS, such notice and public review process commenced on December 11, 2009, at least forty-five days in advance of the January 26, 2010 meeting of the Panel at which the proposed re-siting came before the Panel for a vote; and

WHEREAS, following the public review and comment period, the Panel made available to the public, including via the Department of Education's internet web site, an assessment of all public comments concerning the proposed re-siting of P.S. 204X; and

WHEREAS, the assessment of public comments included a summary and analysis of the issues raised and any significant suggested alternatives; a statement of the reasons why any significant alternatives were not incorporated into the proposed re-siting; a description of any changes to the proposed re-siting as a result of the public comments; and information regarding where the full text of any approved re-siting of P.S. 204X may be obtained; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel for Educational Policy approve the proposal to move P.S. 204X from its current location to school building X338; and

WHEREAS, the re-siting of P.S. 204X is necessary to provide the school with sufficient space to accommodate all zoned students and to improve elementary school options for students in the northern area of Community School District 9; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Panel for Educational Policy to move P.S. 204X from its current location to school building X338 now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g, the Panel for Educational Policy hereby approves the proposed re-siting of P.S. 204X.
