requirements for naturalization

- Lived in the U.S. as a lawful permanent resident for at least 5 years, or 3 years if married to and living with a U.S. Citizen.
- Have been physically present in the United States for at least half of the 5 (or 3) years.
- Have resided for at least 3 months in the state where you will apply for naturalization.
- Be of good moral character and loyal to the U.S.
- Have basic knowledge and understanding of the history, government structure and the Constitution of the U.S. (some exceptions apply).
- Be able to read, write, speak and understand basic English (some exceptions apply).
- Be willing to take an oath of allegiance to the U.S.
